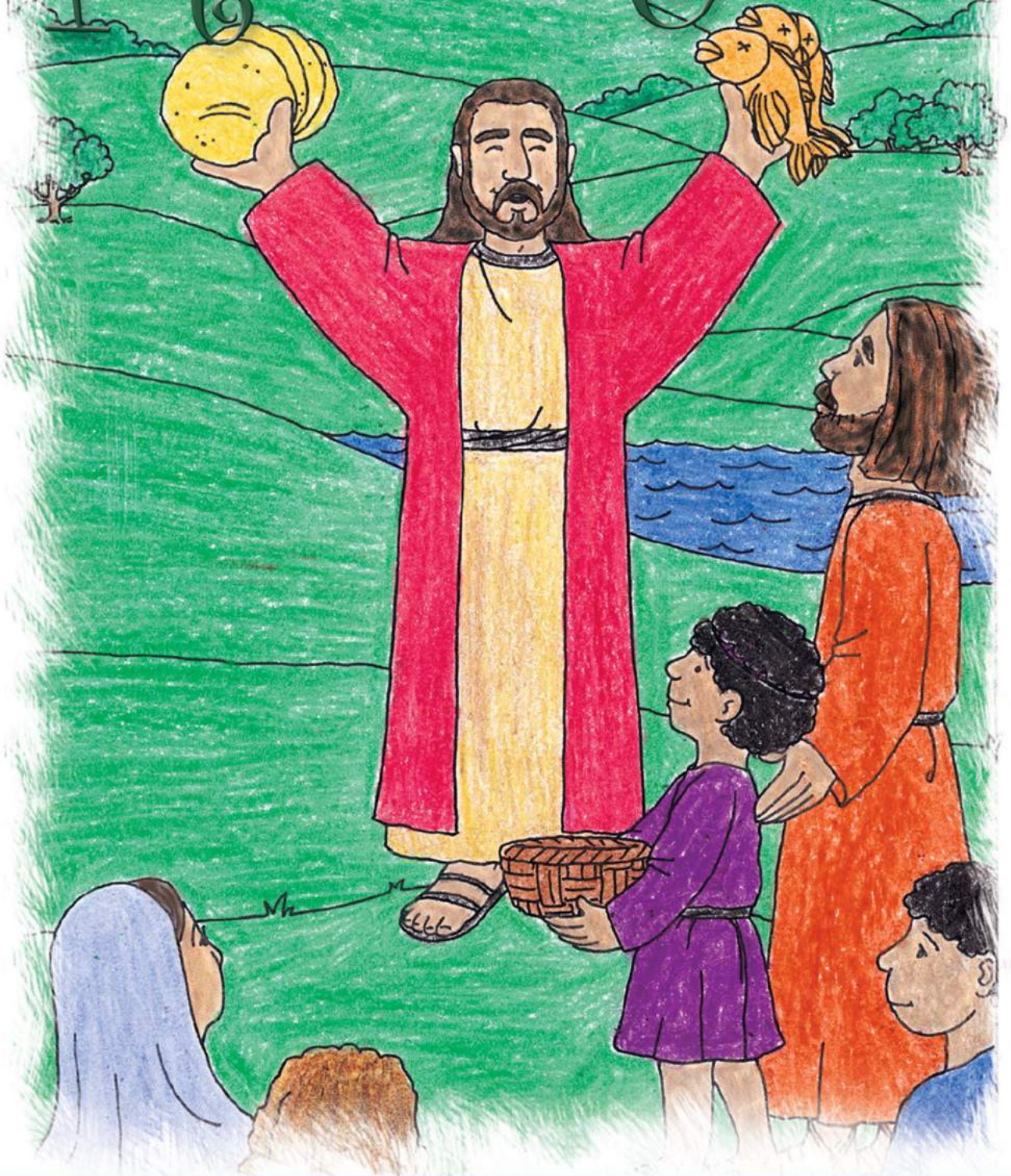




Miracles of Jesus

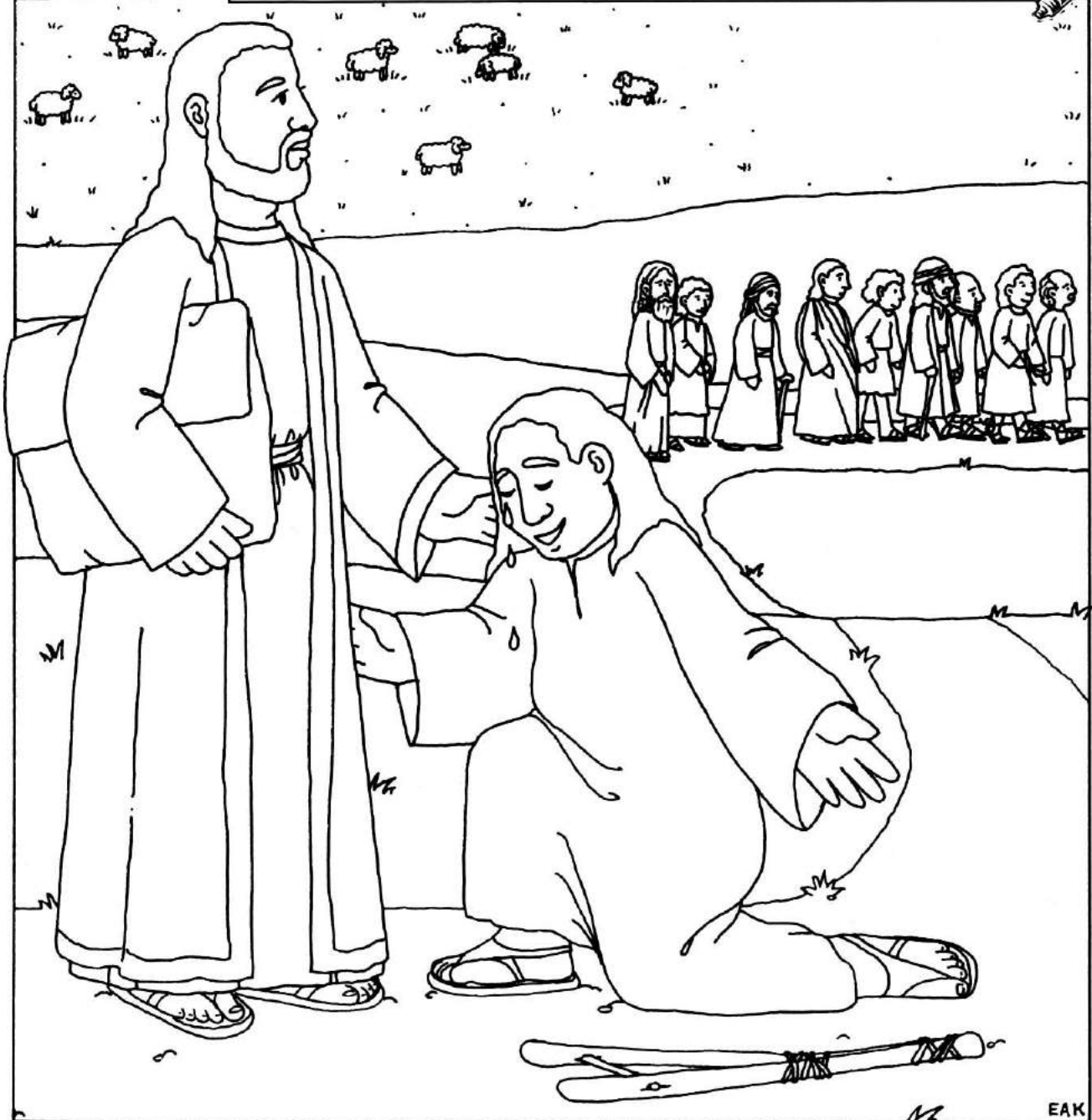

Ten Are Healed

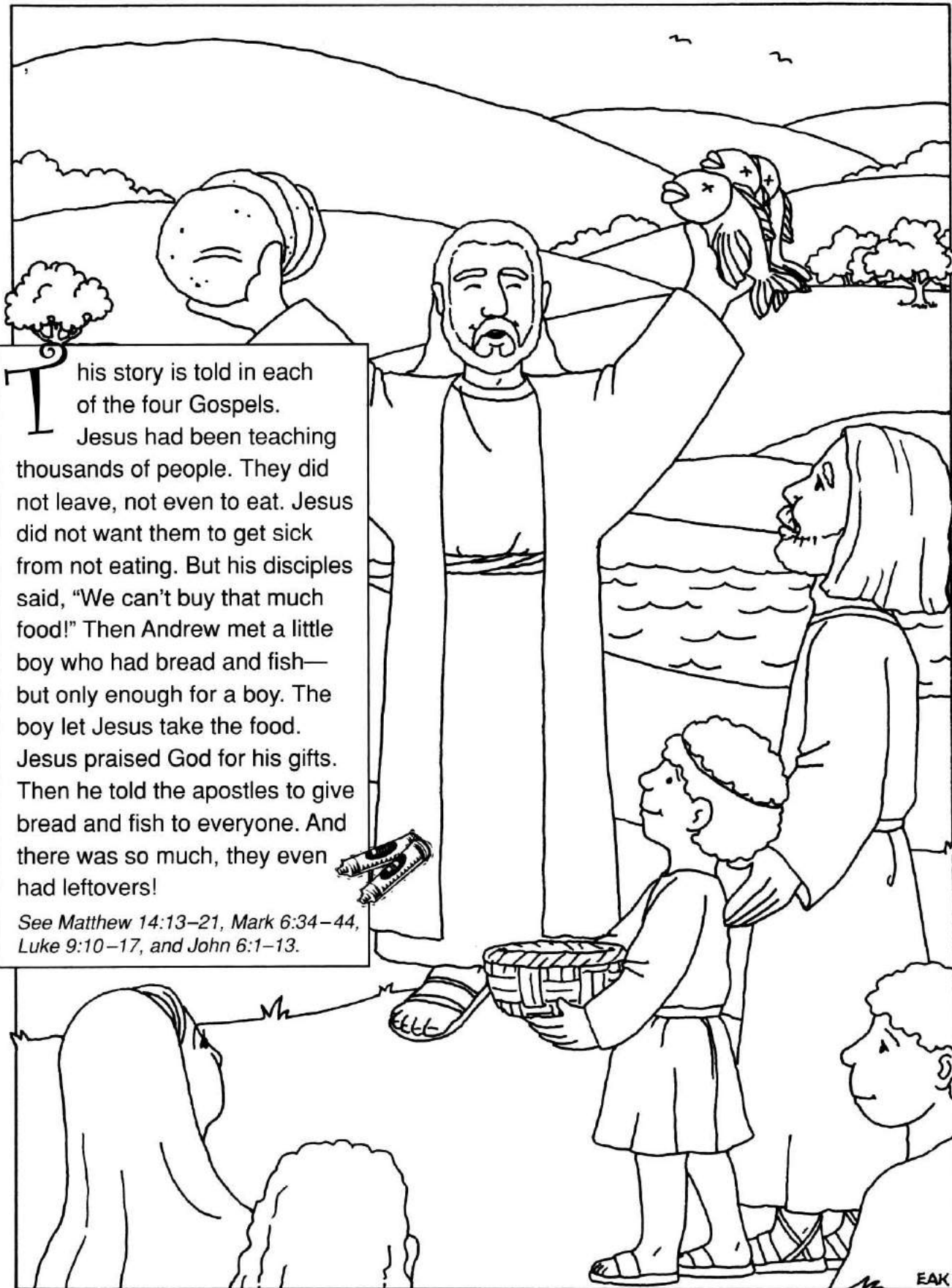

Jesus Feeds the Crowd



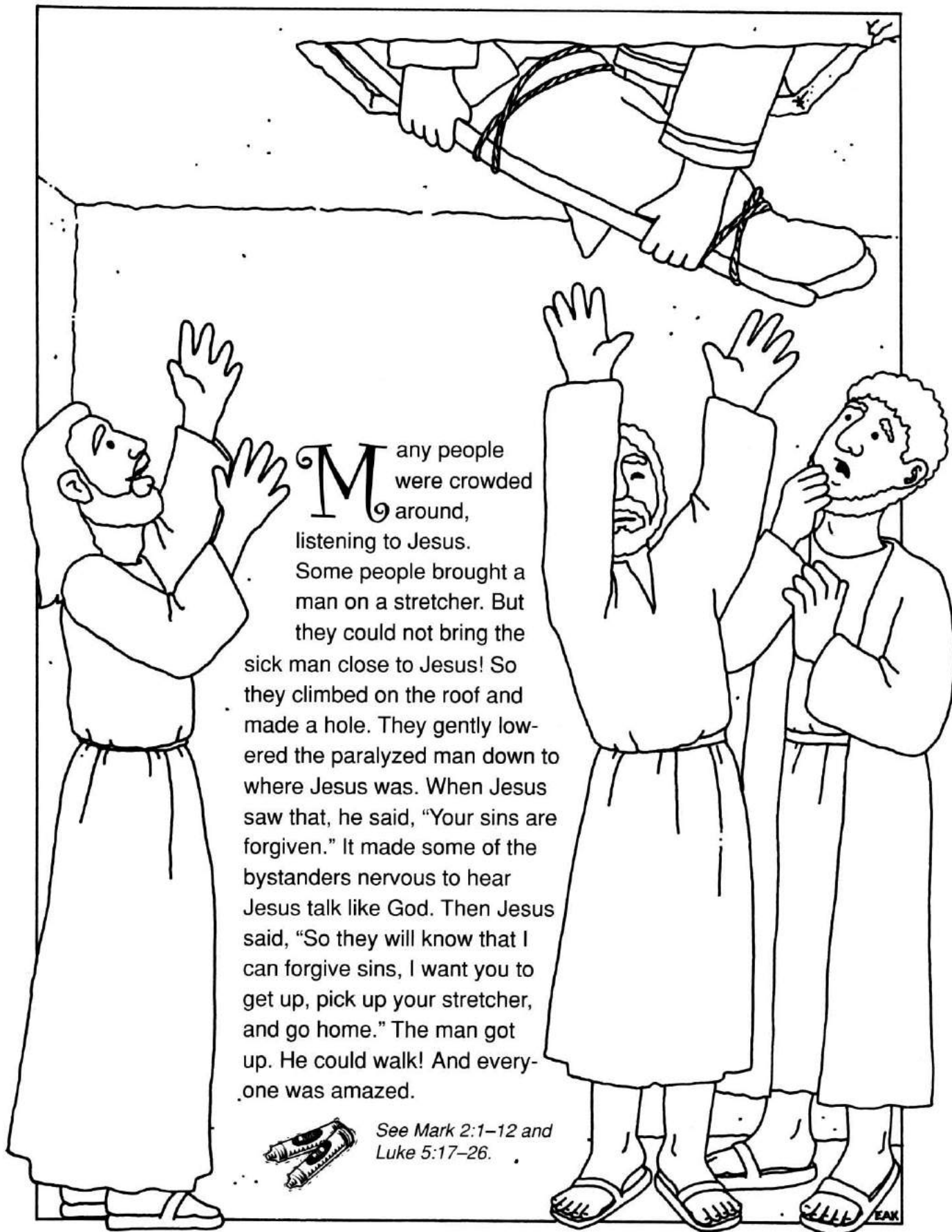
